19 19.1	Minutes The Minutes of the Community Engagement Committee held on 13 th April 2022 were approved as a true and accurate record. Proposed: Cllr Green; Seconded: Cllr Cooney It was agreed that the minutes of the meeting held on 13 th April 2022 be approved.

21 21.1	Income and Expenditure Report The Income and Expenditure Report for April was not available as the Finance Officer had been dealing with the close of year end accounts.

22.2	Artisan Market Thanks went to all for a successful Artisan Market on Saturday. The weather had helped. A video had been done by Cllr Cooney which had gone out on social media and the playing of the busker – JohnnyAllen and the Lea Hall Band had been well received. Cllrs considered that providing the Town Council were not running stalls and events, only one member of staff needed to be available at any one time on market days.	
22.3	Generator It was noted that the solar powered generator which had been considered for purchase was not a viable option for the power needed for events. Staff would therefore purchase one at now more than £616 for use at markets and events.	
22.4	Big Celebration Event See report on website for details A sheet would be circulated to all councillors for them to put down the hours that they could volunteer for and the type of work that they would be able to help with.	
22.5	Cllrs noted the issues around the beacon lighting for the Jubilee on 2 nd June which was being organised by the British Legion. The beacon being supplied is approx. 10ft high and only accepts smokeless wood – rather than the gas beacon requested. Discussions around this event are ongoing but it was proposed that no more than £100 be spent on fuel for the beacon. *Proposed: Cllr Hodgson; Seconded: Cllr Ansell** The motion was agreed	
23 23.1	Mindfulness Garden It was now understood that the Baton Relay for the Commonwealth Games would be passing through Rugeley on 23 rd July at 3.14pm. In order to add value to this event and make it more of a draw for the local people, work was underway to get the garden opened on this day as well.
