<b>20</b> 20.1	Income and Expenditure Report The Income and Expenditure Report for April and May 2023 were noted.	
<b>21</b> 21.1	Artisan Market  Clirs received a report on the Artisan Market. The current providers of the market stalls have pulled out and July market will be their last one. In general, the cost of buying in stalls from a company have risen by approx. 100% since we started the market 2 years ago. Locals are used to coming into the town on the first Saturday and footfall in town on market days has increased.	
21.2	<ul> <li>Cllrs considered the options available to the council which included:</li> <li>buying in ready-made stalls</li> <li>ask stall holders to bring own gazebos until new stalls could be provided. (Market stall holders have been asked if they would provide their own stalls and all but one have said that they would no longer come to Rugeley if they had to provide their own gazebos)</li> <li>getting a new company to come in to provide the service of stall provision on the first Saturdays.</li> <li>It was noted that the market licence held with CCDC in Market Square has now stopped so discussions would take place with CCDC to see if they could help with an Artisan Market in Market Square. July's Artisan Market would be held in Market Square rather than Brook Square.</li> </ul>	An extraordinary
