<b>94</b> 94.1	<b>Income and Expenditure</b> The income and expenditure report for December was noted. It was again noted that the bar sales were higher than last years – to be expected as were still recovering from Covid – but we had already achieved 75% of target at ¾ way through the year. It was also noted that the pantomime in December had broken event despite a couple of cancellations by schools.
