Hearing Loop in Chamber

### Background

Cllrs will recall that in Octobers Full Council meeting, a report was received concerning the legal requirement to make reasonable changes to provide auxiliary aids e.g. induction hearing loop in public buildings. It was agreed that the Town Clerk secure quotes for the work to be done to install and hearing loop and microphones in the Council Chamber. Three companies have quoted, and details of the quotes are listed below.
